### RECOMMENDATION

Appoint members of the Child Nutrition Advisory Council, pursuant to Education Code Section 49533.

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### SUMMARY OF PREVIOUS STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION DISCUSSION AND ACTION

The State Board appoints members to the Child Nutrition Advisory Council (CNAC) pursuant to Education Code Section 49533. The Council is composed, by statute, of 13 members who serve three-year, staggered terms (except for a student representative, who serves a one-year term). Each member is to represent a special interest area within child nutrition, except for one member who is to be a "lay person."

Informally (without appointment by the State Board), the Council has added several "advisory members" to its composition, two being experts in physical education and activity and one being a school business official.

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### SUMMARY OF KEY ISSUES

There are currently two vacancies on the CNAC, a representative of parent-teacher organizations and a lay person. In addition, the school administrator position will be vacant at the end of the 2003-04 school year. Nominees are sought for these vacancies.

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### FISCAL ANALYSIS (AS APPROPRIATE)

Members are not paid, but are reimbursed for travel expenses, which are minimal.
